We dedicate and bless this holy space, this ancient path. Grounded here in this earth, this place, this labyrinth is witness to the sky and wind, sun and moon. Made sacred by its ancient roots this labyrinth will invite and witness our pilgrimage to the heart and soul of life. Made sacred by our intention this labyrinth invites us into a path of deeper meaning.

For those who have burdens too great to bear
