OK at Camp



1. Have fun
2. Be safe
3. Meet new friends
4. Look out for each other
5. Model good behavior for others
6. Demonstrate respect for people, property and facilities.



NOT OK at Camp

1. Gather wood
2. Roughhousing or fighting
3. Swinging or throwing tree branches
4. Behaviors that might injure others
5. Disrespect for people or facilities

Parental Supervision

Parents or guardians are responsible for knowing where their children are, who they are with and always ensuring adult supervision.

UUSS Adult-Child Policy

While at camp, when children are present, two non-related adults must supervise when a parent or caregiver is not there.

Campfire Guidelines

- Fire extinguished by 11pm
- Last person must ensure the fire is out
- Marshmallow toasting
 - Needs adult supervision
 - Caution with sharp skewers
- Keep kids and fire separate

IMPORTANT TO KNOW

- Camp is a smoke free facility
- No glass containers @pool or @firepit
- Use trash receptacles or pack it out
- No public nudity (pool or grounds)
- Everyone is expected to help clean up camp on Sunday. We want everyone to be able to leave at a reasonable time. No UUSSers left behind!

Quiet hours: 10 PM to 7 AM

10-11 PM Socialize quietly at campfire area

Swimming Agreements

- Children must always have adult supervision at the pool.
- Have clear communication with other adults. Do not assume other adults are watching your children without clear confirmation.

Dog Agreements

We want all humans and dogs to feel safe and enjoy their time at All Ages Camp.

- Dogs must be comfortable outdoors, with large groups of adults, children, and other animals.
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times in public
- Owners must be in control of dogs at all times.
- No animals allowed in any camp buildings

Tread Lightly... Play Respectfully

Enjoy the natural surroundings and rustic accommodations. **Only foot traffic is allowed on the meadow.** Leave camp in better condition than when you found it.

Alcohol Agreements

Adults must always be mindful of the presence of young people at camp. Avoid alcohol-impaired behavior or judgment.

- Consume in moderation
- Alcohol only at lunch or after 3 PM
- Leave no alcohol unsecured
