Status of Loan to UUSS for building renovation and expansion

- \$325,000 loan to UUSS was made in 2015
- Interest (1%) paid quarterly (about \$773 per quarter)
- Due on June 30, 2025

Allocations since October 2018

• \$4,500 in June 2019 for safety equipment and training
