The Path

- 1. Review the details of the duties and qualifications.
- 2. Assess your own level of interest, skills / abilities, and desire to rise to this personal enrichment opportunity.
- 3. Read the Application instructions and consider if you are ready to:
 - Write a letter of interest
 - Author a Reflection and submit as a writing sample
 - "Audition" your writing and presentation skills for a small group of friendly Worship Associates
- 4. Make contact with one of the co-chairs. Ask questions.
- 5. Submit your Application. A co-chair will reach out to you to schedule the next step.



The Duties

Presentation is the most visible part of the Worship Associate's role, supporting our ministers in presenting worship services.

You might participate in a service by presenting the Welcome & Announcements, writing and giving a Personal Reflection, presenting a selected reading, leading or assisting with the Chalice Lighting, the offering, or other rituals.

> Many find the experience brings unexpected opportunity for deepening and personal growth

Behind the scenes work typically includes developing slides for services, coming early for setup, and collaboration with ministers, musicians, tech staff, greeters.

Qualifications

- Strong verbal & written communication skills
- Able to work cooperatively in a small group
- Capable of learning how to build PowerPoint slide presentations
- Available to schedule and participate in one or more Sunday morning / Tuesday Eve services per month
- Able to learn how to use Zoom virtual meeting basics
- Attend our team meeting 6-8pm the first Thursday of each month
- Ready to make a two-year commitment to serve as a Worship Associate

- Length about 400 words

Guide for Reflection writing:

- Draw from your personal experience (preaching is the minister's role)
- Tap into and express what you felt at the time
- Share your feelings as this experience unfolded with adequate detail balanced by respect for your privacy
- Consider whether your Reflection identifies what you learned from this experience
- Can you demonstrate if and/or how you were changed by the experience you had

3. Submit all items described above, including this page to both:
